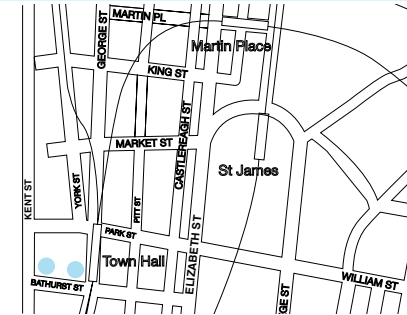


VENUE
